Thoughts on the Gospel

'The author of these passages proposed a list of signs for the end of the world and general witness to those who went out to preach. At the root of both lay the Lord's command to "Go and preach the Good News." 'The author began with order for travelling evangelization. "Go everywhere and preach the Good News to everyone," mirrored Jesus' own mobile ministry. The disciples were to do as Jesus did, but only on a universal scale. In fact, the ministry of Jesus became THE sign of the end times. Instead of judgment, the power of God's Word would be revealed. The Good News would be proclaimed. And evil would be rejected. Those who accepted God's Word would be saved (i.e., they would participate in these signs of the end times). But those who rejected God's Word (who refused to accept the Good News and its accompanying signs) were lost. 'Mark 16:17-18 described five signs of the end times, all done in the name of Jesus. They were: Expelling demons, speaking new things in tongues, picking up snakes (serpents), not being harmed if poison is drunk and healing the weak. Excerpt from www.word-sunday.com
